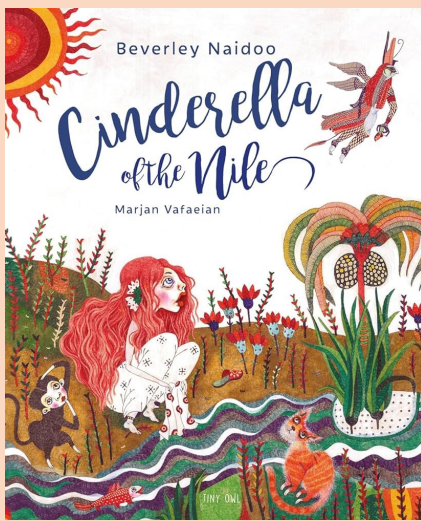

We will be exploring writing the following genres:

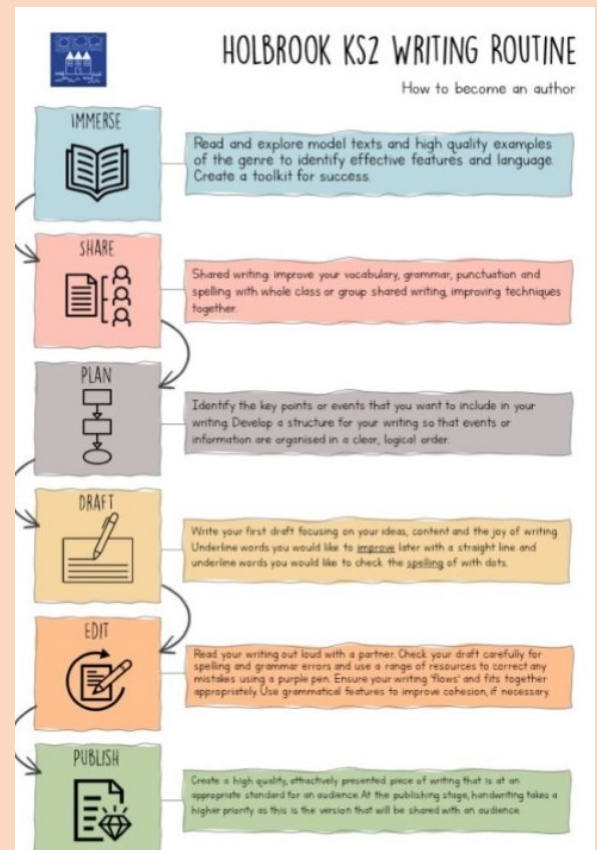
Poetry: Limericks, kennings & haiku

## Spelling

We will be learning the following spelling patterns:

- 6 - Challenge words

- 8 - Words ending in '-tion'
- 9 - Words ending in '-sion'
- 10 - Words ending in '-cian'
- 11 - Words that are adverbs of manner

## Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar

We teach grammar through our writing lessons, exploring the use of language in rich texts. We also provide morning activities for each learning.

We practise handwriting at the beginning of all English lessons.

## Maths

Multiplication & division:

## Science
