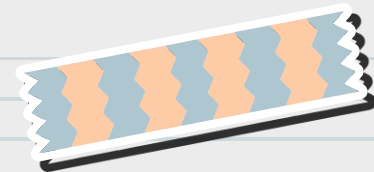


- ▶ Hello lovely Class 2, We will be teaching you in September. We can't wait to get to know you.

What our classroom looks like.....

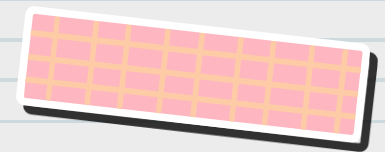
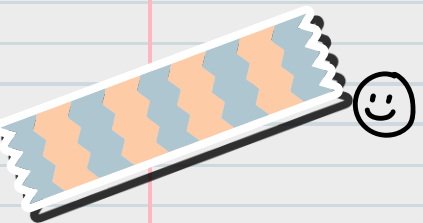
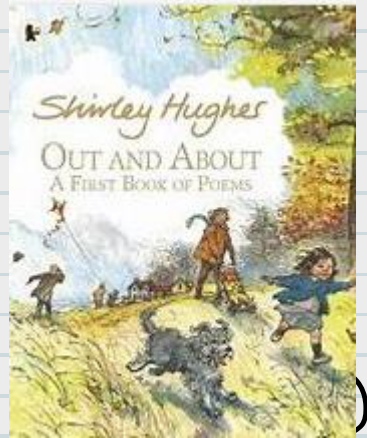
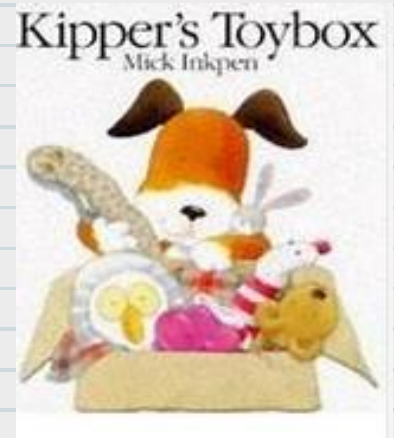
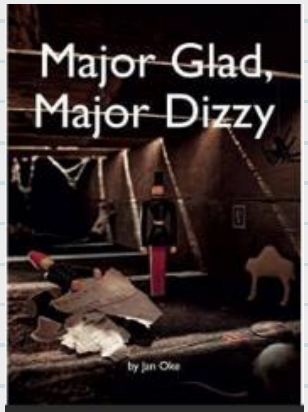
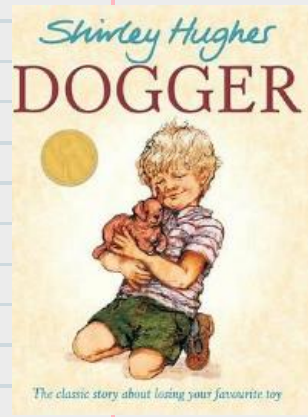

We do our learning in lots of different ways. We balance guided and adult-led activities with plenty of independent learning, where the children are free to explore the ongoing provision in the classroom environment.



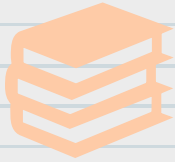

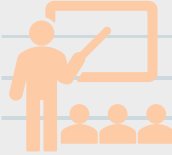




Homework

Children are expected to read at home at least three times a week. Books will be sent home each week. We will continue to follow the Little Wandle program and will be encouraging good fluency and understanding of the text.
