This year we will have three main topics:

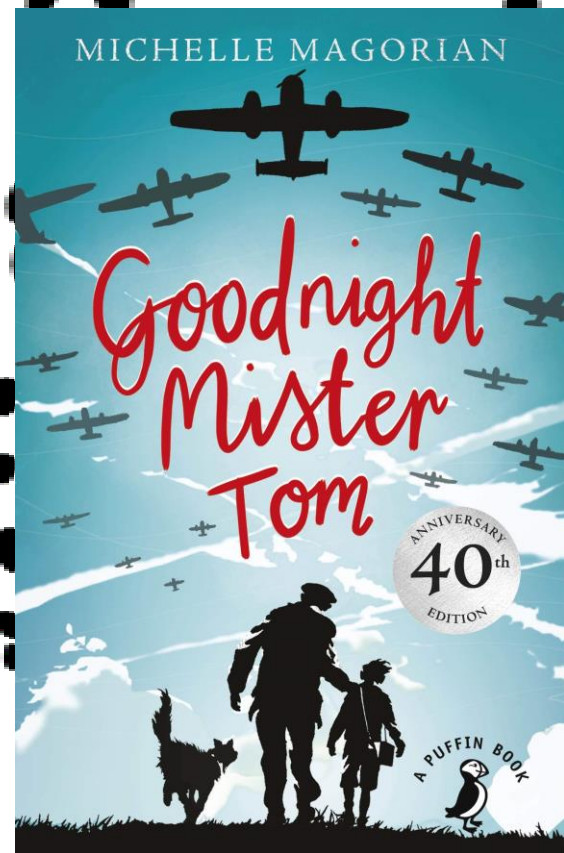
- Into the Unknown

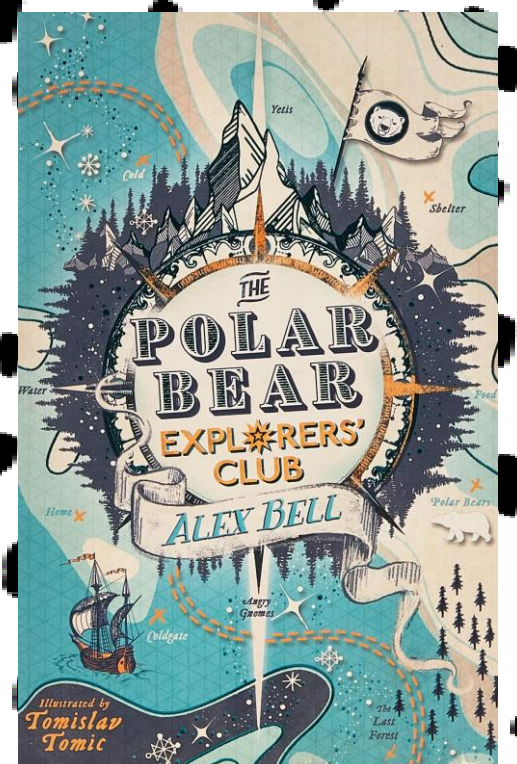


Books
