### Safeguarding reminders:

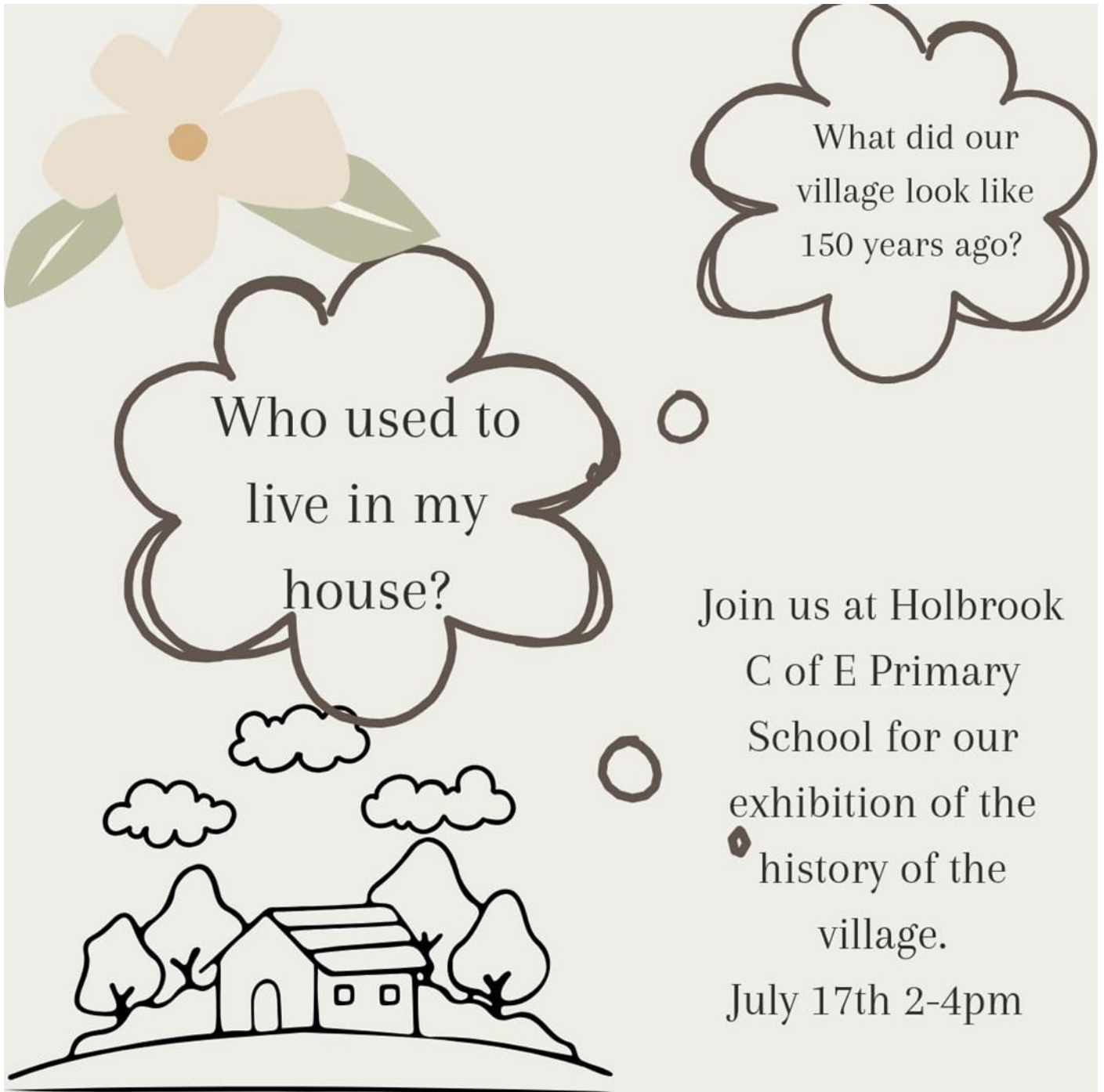
